## **European Commission**

In March 2025, the Commission proposed the `Union of Skills' as the guiding strategy for improving the quality of education, training and lifelong learning. Key strands of the Union of Skills are building basic skills, upskilling and reskilling, circulating skills across the EU and attracting, developing and retaining talent.

A total of 23 initiatives are part of the Union of Skills-strategy like the 'EU strategy for vocational education and training' to make VET more attractive, innovative, and inclusive, a new European VET diploma supporting the free movement of learners and workers and strengthening Centres of Vocational Excellence

Part of the Union of Skills, the STEM Education Strategic Plan also aims to improve STEM in IVET and CVET as VET graduates represent almost half of all STEM graduates. That includes proposing new 2030 EU-level STEM targets also regarding VET, promote future-oriented STEM curricula in VET schools, VET reskilling and upskilling, pilot STEM education centres for VET schools and exchange good practices and foster mutual learning on attracting and supporting girls and women in STEM apprenticeships.
